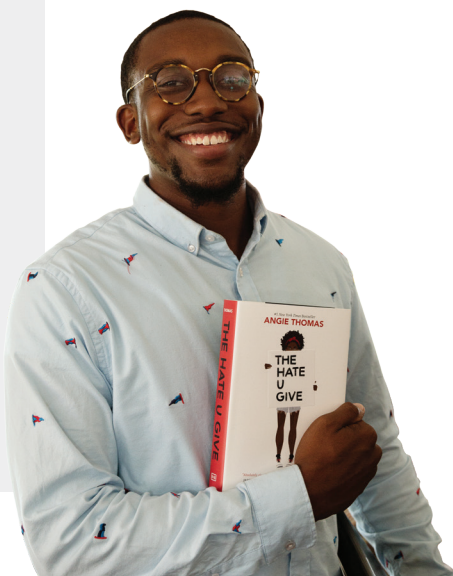
BOOKSELLERS
